We received a heartbreaking message Wednesday morning from the Rev. Tim Krick, <u>Lutheran World Relief</u>'s Senior Advisor of Congregational Engagement:

"I'm coming to you with a report directly from our team in Ukraine, where missile strikes hit cities across the country yesterday - including a children's hospital in Kyiv.

Our Lutheran World Relief team was blocks away at the time the missile hit. They rushed to the hospital - alongside first responders - providing care and support.

As you can imagine, the situation was terrifying and desperate, especially for the young patients and their families.
